



## What is a Jimmy?

You will be part of an intentional mentoring process that will challenge and equip you both personally and spiritually.

While in the office, your duties as Jimmy will include, but are not limited to:

1. **Base Camp preparation.** It is hard to explain how much work goes into getting ready for a Base Camp, so we will just show you when you get here.
2. **Recruiting.** iGo is everywhere during the summer. Jimmy makes appearances at Super Summer, Falls Creek, YEC, etc.
3. **Administrative duties.** AKA your guide to carpal tunnel syndrome. Throughout the summer there will be tons of data entry, sticker cutting, printing, folding, stamping, typing, and other mundane tasks. Welcome to the world of mobilization.
4. **Communication.** Using, email, phone, snail mail, and the occasional homing pigeon, Jimmy is responsible for communicating to students, parents, and churches throughout the summer.

Outside of the office your time will be spent together with your Jimmy leaders. Your time will be intentional and will include eating meals together, growing in community, reading and discussing a book together, spending time with staff families, serving together and having lots of fun!

  - b. Time. Your summer is to be dedicated to this internship.
3. **Hard worker**
  - a. Able to perform administrative tasks
  - b. Comfortable speaking to students, parents, etc. on the phone and in person
  - c. Assertive, as you initiate and complete assigned projects
4. **Fun**
  - a. We work hard at iGo, but we value having a good time no matter what the circumstances.
  - b. Be prepared to laugh

## FAQ's

### Is this a paid position?

Yes. You will receive \$150 per week served.

### Will I go overseas and who pays for my overseas trip?

We prefer that our interns serve in our office all summer; however, there are occasions when we need extra help on some of our larger teams in leadership roles. If you desire to serve, then you will serve on

one of our partnership trips with Super Summer or Falls Creek, which are one week long. If you serve overseas on one of our short-term teams, you will be expected to raise the money for that trip.

**Where will I live during the summer?**

Our offices are in Lavin, Texas (10 miles north of Rockwall). We will assign you to a host home or will provide group housing for the Jimmy team relatively close to the office. If you have friends or relatives in the Rockwall/Wylie area that you could stay with, please let us know.

**Do I have to commit to the entire summer?**

Yes. In order to build community and experience the intended growth through this internship it is imperative that you be all here.

**How much free time will I have?**

Very little true free time. We will make sure you have time to yourself every week, but you need to think of this internship like a mission trip. You will be “doing life” with the other interns while you build Biblical community. Therefore, it is imperative that you participate in all scheduled activities. If you need time away for any reason, that will need to be approved in advance by the Jimmy supervisor.
